a. We are hiring for Executive Director, Trail Maintenance Labourer, Summer Trail Crew Youth Position, Summer Communications Coordinator.

Joe Woywitka is leaving in June for school - will remain involved with the association (trail work + report). Discussions about keeping Joe more involved through his schooling with some kind of scholarship/bursary/grant-- promoting people retention under Priority B.

Summer positions are provided pending funding from the Government of Canada (Youth Employment Program).

All positions will have open and close dates at the exception of ED, which will remain open until we find the right person.

Financial Update

- Bank balance as of March 1st \$292K!!
- Cash flow updated for March
 - 2021 Cash Flow Budget
- Presented by Katherine Enns
- Spending ideas: Ben Lovie proposes that we set money aside for advertising to increase memberships digital marketing. Possibility to pay contractors to take care of trails due to lack of trail days/TAP, where permits allow (challenging as it doesn't solve problems with certain trails where permits do not allow). Possibility of inviting trail builders to provide a work plan for additional trails days (4) on top of their 6 TAP days.
- Kat (supported by others) will create a Policy for spending

Ben Lovie put forward a motion for \$3,000 in member recruitment.

Land Managers Update

a. **Metro** - IMBA Update - Christine met with Metro Vancouve (Q2) last Thursday - AJ at IMBA and Patrick at Metro. Updated them on Seymour trails, they are interested in co-hosting a trail day (postpone until Q3 meeting in July), clarified what unsponsored trails are versus TAP Trails, report back to what will happen on Seymour: Interested in us working on Cambodia, Neds, bridge on CBC. Waiting on the report from IMBA: TTF, changes, adaption, reroute.

- Positive discussion and relationship moving forward.
- b. **BC Parks -** No updates
- c. **CMHC (RSTBC)** No updates
- d. **Grouse Mountain** Update: new blue tram then possible development. Jackie talked with the GM at Grouse. No opportunity at this time. No desire to support development of new trails in 7th Secret area. Will probably reach out to us in a year or two so NSMBA can help them with another project.
- e. **District of West Vancouver** Joe and Cooper went to look at trails and are working on a proposal. Hoping to sanction some sections of Mystery, Jersey Shore, Meat Sweat, develop MTB climbing and hiking trail in the area. Some signage was put up at the top of Mystery.
- f. **District of North Vancouver** New staff at DNV, Fromme Agreement James, Christine and Cooper went over the agreement and sent to DNV. Stephanie (Don's friend) has joined DNV, the first call with her was great. DNV approved the Covid Protocols so we can proceed with TAP/Private trail days.
- g. **City of North Vancouver -** Loutet Park Builders will send us a proposal before they send to the city.

Events and Races

- a. DNV is currently not permitting events in 2021. This will continue to change as health orders and restrictions change.
- b. Destination Raffle: Launch Thursday April 8th, to run for 10 weeks (draw on June 16th @7:30pm)

- Make sure the language around Covid and non-essential travels is on point
- c. Social Badger: May 31st or June 7th. Offer stickers available for pick-up at sponsor for completed badges. Invitation to everyone, not members only. We have declined to promote discounts at partners in the past and will stand on this decision.

- d. Summer Scavenger Hunt Mountain Bike Edition: Partner with CMTR to run event mid-July through mid-September. 20 Badges over 2 months to achieve. Inclusive of activity and of location. Include other mountain bike clubs. Invite participants to donate, increase community engagement. Moving forward with the event, Jackie will continue the discussions with CMTR.
- e. T-Day multi-trail day in one day event celebrate re-launch of volunteer days
- f. Town Hall Meeting in May Virtual will send a couple of dates options for Directors to

decide.

g. Coast Mental Health Courage 2 Go Further - More of a challenge to raise funds going to CMH. They are asking our help to promote on social/website and to find a famous mountain biker to help promote (female and male).
