- a. Cypress East Climb Trail Update
  - i. Working on route flagging (Blue) but the dirt is not good (initial route was over 4km long)
  - ii. Looking at building a hiking-only trail to keep the hikers out of the biking trails

- a. Stakeholder meetings for new Natural Areas Trail Strategy (community and one-on-one)

  - i. Stemming from 2007 Fromme Mountain Sustainable Trail Use and Classification
     Plan DNV noticed that many items in the plan have not been executed
  - ii. This means potential new trail development identified for NSMBA Extension to Bobsled (between 2& 3rd switchback) and a connector to bypass Baden Powell between Expresso and Mtn Hwy.
