Election of officers

1. Nominations

- a. **President:** Jimmy Nadel (incumbent), nominated by Kevin Johnstone, votes passes unanimously
- b. Vice-President: Eleri Harris, nominated by Kat Enns, vote passes unanimously
- c. Treasurer: Kat Enns (incumbent), nominated by Jimmy Nadel, vote passes unanimously
- d. Secretary: Kevin Johnstone, nominated by Kat Enns, vote passes unanimously
- 2. Only appointed 9 directors this year, gives us flexibility to add more directors throughout the year to add missing resource or address lack of diversity

Responsible Land Use

1. Trails for All

- a. Want to understand where board members are at, what training might be useful to new and existing board members
- Various levels of experience but most board members would benefit from some training on First Nations and diversity
- c. Deanne provided update on previous work with Tsleil-Waututh and new grant application for 2023
- d. Steve mentioned that it would be useful to have focus and strategic plan as diversity is a broad topic
- e. Potentially establish Trails for All committee
- 2. Discussion about where to put proceeds of 25th Anniversary merch sales
 - a. Need to announce this in February
 - Agreement in principle but need to discuss the details and overall strategy for engagement with First Nations
 - c. Todd suggested having First Nations carvers work on heritage trees on certain trails

Community Impact

- 1. Same Game Challenge
 - a. Program run by Canadian Women in Sport

- b. 6 month program where we work with a mentor who walks us through a gender equity tool
- c. Able to bring 5 people from NSMBA

Financial Resilience

- 1. Purchasing Policy Update
 - a. Cooper will go to bank soon to remove himself from the account
- 2. Thriving Non-Profit Program
 - a. Have been accepted into this program, run by the West Vancouver Foundation
 - b. Helping non-profits diversify finances
- 3. Confirm assumptions for membership revenue
 - a. Budget was based on 4,000 members (\$200k)
 - b. Should report number of members vs target monthly in board agenda
- 4. Confirm assumptions for sponsorship revenue
 - a. Budget was based on \$130k for TAP and sponsorship combined (\$80k for TAP and \$50k for sponsorships)

Membership Updates

- 1. Update on current membership & growth
 - a. Lots of members didn't renew in January 2022, membership dropped from high of ~3k
 in December 2021
 - b. Average renewal rate was 58%
 - c. Improved membership reminder emails
 - d. Peak season spike in membership in May
 - e. Currently 43% of members have auto-renew turned on
 - f. Update on current and upcoming marketing activities

Operational Updates

1. Membership Amendments

a. Opportunity for improving membership and providing more options for how to donate and making it easier

2. Fivers

- a. Intro to Fivers event prior to Fiver season
- b. 4 "chill" Fivers (on Saturdays) and 4 regular Fivers (starting with chill)
- c. Also youth specific Fiver
- d. Discussion about women's specific Fiver(s)
- e. Need to decide how season pass would work

Directors and Committee Updates

- 1. Long-term project: Review of TAP program
 - a. Kevin going to interview TAP builders to see what additional support they would like from the NSMBA
- 2. Shorter-term project: Review/revival of Trail Academy
 - a. Board priority to revive this in 2023
