LONG LIVE THE NSMBA

The North Shore is a world-renowned trail destination and a significant Vancouver tourism attraction. The vast trail network has been built and nurtured through thousands of hours of advocacy and volunteer work. Without the NSMBA and our ongoing dedication this network of incredible trails could be lost.

The NSMBA works collaboratively with land managers to ensure trails are safe, waterways are respected and our land is sustained for years to come.

The NSMBA is at the heart of the mountain bike community on the Shore and provides access to events, trail days and opportunities to give back.

We continue to work towards building relationships with local indigenous communities and creating opportunities for increased access for more diverse populations to enjoy the trails.



Mount Seymour has seen 17,000 unique riders in 2023, the trails have been ridden over 1.2 million times.

Rides on Mount Seymour alone increased **97%** between **2019-2021** and continue to show consistent growth.

"Tens of thousands of people across the Metro Vancouver region and around the world visit the Fromme Mountain area, and those visitor numbers are increasing each year." - DNV.org

Increases in the number of hikers, trail runners and dog walkers have also being reported across the trails.

Note: not every rider tracks their ride using Trailforks and it doesn't account for users from other activities like trail runners or hikers. Therefore, the usage on the trails is more than reported.
