## E. Goal Setting Discussion (30 mins)

- a. Review of 2025 OKR's
  - i. Objective 1
    - 1. KR1 is mostly done and we'll be doing open house in October
    - 2. KR2 will be done after the open house, before the end of 2025
    - 3. KR3 hasn't been done yet
    - 4. Thinking has evolved on how to create the strategy, Mike and Cynthia and Trails Working Group to revise objective and KRs for 2026
  - ii. Objective 2
    - 1. KR1 membership revenue is a bit lower \$173,000
    - 2. KR2 sponsorship revenue currently lower \$133,600
    - 3. KR3 merchandise revenue way lower \$4,000
    - 4. KR4 haven't been pushing this
  - iii. Objective 3
    - 1. KR1 we did a community survey, but didn't get ⅓ of members responding (actually 556 responses which is ~20% of members)
    - 2. KR2 will be done as a community impact report
    - 3. Anjulie will send community impact report to Cynthia

  - i. Trail apprenticeship program
  - ii. Break-even financial position
  - iii. Membership growth, increasing awareness and adding more benefits for membership
  - iv. Rethinking sponsorship strategy

  - viii. Pay a Living Wage (\$27 per hour)
